ORDER SCHEDULING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND

Socket Telecom, LLC, filed a complaint against CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel, on January 8, 2008. After an unsuccessful attempt at mediation, CenturyTel and Spectra filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss, Answer, Affirmative Defenses and Counterclaim on September 12. Socket's reply to that pleading is due by September 22.

In order to move this complaint to a prompt resolution, the Commission will schedule a prehearing conference to discuss a procedural schedule.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Socket Telecom, LLC, shall file its reply to CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel's Joint Motion to Dismiss, Answer, Affirmative Defenses and Counterclaim no later than September 22, 2008.

2. A prehearing conference is scheduled for September 29, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
