### JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(now known as Southwestern Bell Telephone Company) d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T"), collectively referred to herein as the "Parties," and for their *Joint Motion to Establish Procedural Schedule* the Parties respectfully state:

December 21, 2012: Position Statements

January 4, 2013: All Hearing Exhibits filed in EFIS by

11:59 p.m.<sup>2</sup>

January 8-9, 2013: Hearing on the Merits

3. During the pre-hearing conference, the Parties agreed that no discovery requests would be filed in this case after Monday, December 10, 2012, which is 30 days before the first scheduled hearing date.

**WHEREFORE**, the Parties jointly move the Commission to adopt this proposed procedural schedule and discovery cut-off date.
