1. On October 16, 2012, the Staff made its Complaint in this matter. Respondent Transcom Enhanced Services, Inc. (“Transcom”) and the Staff have submitted a Stipulation and Agreement for Commission approval, which, if approved, will fully resolve all pending issues pertaining to Transcom.

2. Halo Wireless, Inc. (“Halo”) did not answer or respond in any way. The Staff renews its Motion that the Commission enter a default determination against that company, which the Staff filed on April 23, 2013.

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission enter a default determination that Halo acted as a telecommunications company in the State of Missouri and should have been certificated as such prior to providing telecommunications service in Missouri.
