## ORDER CANCELING TECHNICAL CONFERENCE AND SUSPENDING THE REQUIREMENT FOR FILING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 24, 2006, the Commission set a technical conference in this matter to be held on January 16, 2007. In that same order the Commission required the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than January 23, 2007.

On January 15, 2007, Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE ("AmerenUE") filed a motion to reschedule the technical conference. In its motion, AmerenUE states that due to the ice storms hitting portions of AmerenUE's service territory between the dates of January 12 through 14, the Supervising Engineer that planned to attend the conference will be busy with power restoration efforts. AmerenUE states that it has contacted all of the parties to this action and that no party opposes rescheduling the conference.

The Commission finds the request to be reasonable and shall grant it. Additionally, the deadline for filing a procedural schedule shall be suspended and shall be reset in a

subsequent order for a date to follow the technical conference. The parties shall submit a new date for the technical conference no later than January 23, 2007.

- 1. The technical conference scheduled for January 16, 2007, at Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE's Potosi office is canceled.
- 2. No later than January 23, 2007, the parties shall provide the Commission with a new date for holding the technical conference.
