On May 1, 2006, AT&T Missouri filed its answer to Mr. Mark's Complaint and a motion to strike certain paragraphs from the complaint. On May 9, 2006, Mr. Mark filed a motion seeking additional time to respond to the motion to strike because of a previously scheduled vacation in May. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) provides that parties are allowed not more than 10 days to respond to a motion, unless the Commission orders otherwise. Rule 4 CSR 240-2.050(3) allows the Commission, within its discretion, to enlarge the period of time for a responsive pleading. The Commission will grant Mr. Mark's motion and allow additional time to file a responsive pleading.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Complainant is granted until May 31, 2006, to file a response to AT&T's motion to strike.

2. This order shall become effective on May 10, 2006.
