On August 23, 2006, Big River Telephone Company, LLC, (hereafter "Big River") filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri (hereafter "AT&T Missouri"), alleging that AT&T Missouri had charged Big River amounts for local switching and loops beyond the rates set forth in a Commission-approved interconnection agreement. Big River and the Commission's Staff (hereafter "Staff") requested that the Commission stay these proceedings pending appeal of the federal district court order reversing the Commission's interconnection agreement order.

On January 26, 2009, AT&T Missouri renewed a motion to dismiss pending before the Commission. AT&T Missouri states that it has prevailed in the federal litigation against Big River and the Commission, which means that the Commission must dismiss Big River's petition. The Commission will order Big River and Staff to respond to AT&T Missouri's latest pleading.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- Big River Telephone Company, LLC, and the Staff of the Commission shall respond to AT&T Missouri's Renewed Motion to Dismiss Complaint no later than February 6, 2009.
