ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On April 23, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a complaint against Sprint Communications Company, L.P. In response, Sprint filed an Answer, Motion to Dismiss and, in the Alternative, Request for Waiver.

On July 26, 2007, per Commission order, the parties filed a Motion to Adopt the Parties' Proposed Joint Procedural Schedule. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. But because no parties oppose the motion, the Commission will dispense with the ten-day period for responses, and the Commission will consider the proposed schedule unopposed. The Commission finds the proposed procedural schedule reasonable, and will adopt it.

1. The parties' Motion to Adopt the Parties' Proposed Joint Procedural Schedule is granted, and the proposed schedule is adopted.
