## **ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS**

On November 7, 2007, Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC, Cellco Partnership, St. Joseph Celltelco and CyberTel Cellular Telephone Company filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, alleging that AT&T Missouri has unlawfully denied Verizon Wireless' request to extend their interconnection agreement. The complainants filed a Motion to Stay Proceedings on January 10, 2008.
