Mr. Nixon may not represent the corporation. An attorney must represent the corporation.

If complainant wishes to proceed with this complaint before the Commission, it must

engage an attorney for representation. This case will remain open for 90 days to allow time

for an attorney to enter an appearance on behalf of the company.
