PROPOSED NOTICE OF HEARING

NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Stoddard County Sewer Company (“SCSC”) and others have requested that the Public Service Commission (“PSC”) authorize SCSC to transfer its sewer assets to R.D. Sewer Co., L.L.C. The applicants have also requested that, if the transfer is approved, R.D. Sewer Co., L.L.C. be granted an interim rate increase for the sewer service that it will provide. The proposed increase would raise the current flat rate of \$11.40 per month to a flat rate of approximately \$22.80 per month.

Your comments on the proposed transfer of assets and on the proposed interim rate increase are requested. All public comments will be considered by the PSC when deciding whether to grant or reject the application to transfer assets and the proposed interim rate increase.
