NOTICE CLOSING CASE

On January 10, 2006, the Commission approved a Stipulation and Agreement in this case which, among other things, made the Greenwood exchange a mandatory Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA) Plan exchange in the Kansas City MCA. Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri's compliance tariff became effective June 29, 2006. The order also directed that until January 1, 2010, AT&T Missouri shall file a notice in this case if it increases the MCA rates for the Greenwood exchange. The notice is to be filed within two weeks of the effective date of the increase.

On September 11, 2007, AT&T Missouri notified the Commission that effective September 7, 2007, residential service rates in the Greenwood exchange increased by \$2.50 as part of the rate increase for residential service (flat-rate one-party, message one-party, flat-rate trunk, and measured one-party) in all competitively classified exchanges.

The Commission has reviewed AT&T Missouri's notice and finds that it complies with the Commission's January 10, 2006 order.

As no further action is needed at this time, the Commission will close this case.
