STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), by and through counsel, and submits its Staff Recommendation in Case No. IK-2009-0220 as follows:

- 1. On November 21, 2008, Grand River Mutual Telephone Corporation (Grand River of the Company) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (the Commission) its Application Of Grand River Mutual Telephone Corporation For Approval Of An Interconnection And Reciprocal Compensation Agreement Under The Telecommunications Act Of 1996 (Application), in which Grand River seeks approval of an Interconnection and Reciprocal Compensation Agreement (Interconnection Agreement) between the Company and Sprint Spectrum L.P., d/b/a Sprint PCS (Sprint PCS) pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2. On November 26, 2008, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Notice and Making Sprint PCS a Party*, directing notice be sent to interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies, joining Sprint PCS as party to the case, setting an intervention deadline, and directing Staff to file a memorandum regarding Grand River's *Application* by December 29, 2008.
- 3. The statutory standard for review of an interconnection and resale agreement can be found in Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, which states that an interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation shall be submitted for approval to the state commission, but that the state commission may only reject such agreement if it discriminates

against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if its implementation is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 42 U.S.C. § 252(e)(2).

- 4. In the attached memorandum, labeled Appendix A, Staff states that the Interconnection Agreement does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not parties to the Interconnection Agreement and that the Interconnection Agreement is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.
- 5. Grand River is not delinquent in filing its annual report, or in paying its PSC assessment, or MoUSF and Relay Missouri surcharges.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission approve the *Application* and direct the parties to submit to the Commission any subsequent modifications or amendments to the Interconnection Agreement.
