Dear Kim:

This correspondence is to inform the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) of the pending merger between Craw-Kan Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Craw-Kan"), a member-owned telephone cooperative, and its wholly-owned subsidiary Craw-Kan Communications Systems, Inc. ("CKCS"). Both entities have waived the Missouri PSC statutes requiring approval of mergers, consolidations, reorganizations, and transfers. (*See* File Nos. IE-2011-0080 and XE-2011-0089.) Accordingly, no prior PSC approval is required for this transaction.

Currently, Craw-Kan has a certificate of service authority from the PSC as an incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC), and CKCS has a certificate of service authority as an interexchange carrier (IXC). As a result of the merger, CKCS will merge with and into Craw-Kan, with Craw-Kan as the surviving corporate entity and thus assuming CKCS's IXC certificate and customers and adopting CKCS's tariffs.

This notice is being provided to update the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) about the change and request that the data center take any necessary steps to reflect that Craw-Kan will provide service under both the ILEC and IXC certificates of service authority and tariffs beginning on January 1, 2011. Craw-Kan has made a concurrent tariff filing to accomplish the tariff adoption, and a copy is attached.

Craw-Kan has reviewed its EFIS contacts list and determined that no changes are necessary to reflect the reorganization.

If you have any questions or need more information, please contact me at your convenience. Otherwise, I appreciate your assistance and cooperation in making the necessary EFIS changes to reflect this reorganization on and after January 1, 2011.
