- 2. Workpapers shall be emailed or otherwise provided to all counsel of record within 24 hours of the filing of written testimony.
- 3. In addition to cross examination at the hearing, rebuttal testimony in response to written Direct Testimony filed on July 11, 2018, and surrebuttal testimony in response to written Rebuttal Testimony filed on July 11, 2018, may be presented at the hearing. There may be witnesses at the hearing in addition to those who offer pre-filed written testimony.
- 4. The parties further make the following agreements regarding data requests and other discovery:
 - a. Prior to the filing date for the non-Company parties to file Direct/Rebuttal Testimony, the response time for all data requests shall be five (5) business days, with two (2) business days to object or notify the requesting party that more than five business days will be needed to provide the requested information.
 - b. For data requests served on and after the filing date for the non-Company parties to file Direct/Rebuttal Testimony, the response time for all data requests shall be three (3) business days, with two (2) business days to object or notify the requesting party that more than three business days will be needed to provide the requested information.
 - c. All data requests, subpoenas, or other discovery requests shall be issued no later than July 16, 2018. With respect to deposing a witness, depositions must be completed by July 16, 2018.

d. Copies of all data requests, subpoenas, and other discovery requests shall, on

the day of issuance, be sent by email to all counsel of record for all parties (with

the exception of data requests to and/or from Staff which are filed in EFIS).

e. Data requests served (or entered in EFIS, for Staff) prior to 5:00 p.m. Central

on any date shall be deemed issued on said date. Data requests served (or

entered in EFIS, for Staff) at or after 5:00 p.m. Central on any date shall be

deemed issued on the following date.
