APPLICATION

Missouri Public Service Commission

COMES NOW, Tri-State Utility, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Company") and pursuant to Paragraph 393.170, RSMo 2000 and 4 CSR 240-2.060 (4) (A) and states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a Missouri corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri with its principal office and place of business located at 2580 State Highway 165, Branson, Missouri currently provides water service to members of the public located within incorporated and unincorporated areas of Taney County of Missouri and, accordingly, is subject to the jurisdiction, control and regulations of the Commission as provided by law.

3. Applicant previously applied for and received a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) from the Commission to provide service in its existing service territory in Commission Case NO. WO-92-257.

Case No. WO-92-257 resulted in an Order approving unanimous, and stipulation and agreement granting a certificate of Convenience and Necessity, approving tariffs.

- 4. Applicant requests permission, approval and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to extend, install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system for the public in areas adjacent to its existing territory all located in the unincorporated area in Taney County, Missouri, as set forth on the map marked as Exhibit D (the unshaded area). The area adjacent to its existing territory and identified in Exhibit D, highlighted in yellow is the proposed new area. The extended and enlarged CCN added to the original CCN from the Commission, Case NO. WO-92-257 is as set forth in Exhibit B, adjacent to the existing territory set forth in Exhibit C.
- 5. In accordance with 4CSR 240-2.060(4)(A)(5), Applicant prepared one feasibility study in case WO-92-257 which, among other things, describes the existing well and service mains owned, operated, controlled, managed, and maintained subsequent to the approval of the funding request of the Commission in 1994, Commission Case No. WO-92-257.
- 6. There are no municipalities located within the proposed area, and approval by Taney County is not required for the Applicant to provide the water services to this area. The issuance of construction and operation permits from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") were obtained in 1994 during construction of said well and standpipe that is currently under operation, is not applicable to this application. Applicant expects that its water system will meet all future requirements of the DNR.
- 7. Three are no other public utilities or governmental bodies being operated or rendering service within the area proposed to be served.
- 8. The area requested to be certified is comprised of approximately 56 lots that are proposed for a residential subdivision, an additional thirty-five acres proposed as an industrial park with motel(s), and ten residential homes currently being serviced by the Company.

Water service to these residential subdivisions and commercial developments, absent Commission approval of the CCN area enlargement and extension would consist of multiple drilled wells into the aquifer. The nature of the problems of operating a multitude of individual drilled wells is the possible negative impact on the quality of the aquifer which provides a source of drinking water to all residents of the area. Therefore, public need exists for the adequate water service within the proposed area to be served, and the public convenience and necessity will be promoted by the granting of the authority herein requested.

- 9. A certificate from the Missouri Secretary of State evidencing the corporate good standing of Applicant is attached hereto as Exhibit F. See 4CSR 240-2.060 (1)(B).
- 10. Applicant has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involved customer service or rates in which action, judgments or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this application.
 - 11. Applicant has no annual report or assessment fees which are currently overdue.
- 12. Attached as Exhibit A is a narrative that outlines the history of Tri-State Utility, Inc. as well as its officers. Exhibit B is the legal description of the new certificate area to be

added; Exhibit C, the legal description as is on file with the current tariff as issued by the P.S.C.; Exhibit D, maps outlining the location of the proposed new certificate area to be added; and Exhibit E current customers in the proposed new certificate area to be added that are currently being served by Tri-State Utility, Inc. and some additional proposed and ongoing development projects that have requested water service; and Exhibit F, verification of Corporate good standing.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Commission grant it permission, approval and a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity authorizing it to install, acquire, build, construct, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a water system for the public within the area referred to in paragraph 4, authorizing Applicant to implement rates and charges for the provision of water service consistent with those contained in the feasibility study originally presented in Commission case WO-92-257, and for such other orders as the Commission deems proper under the circumstance.



Tri-State Utility, Inc was formed in 1965 to build Branson its first common potable water supply for its citizens. Expansion of the utility has continued and as Branson became a viable municipality, it purchased the initial water system and twice has added system sections as its boundary has increased. Tri-State Utility, Inc has over 2700 active customers, while Branson slightly more.

Tri-States Utility, Inc has in its remaining inventory two water reservoir/pressure tanks with a nominal capacity of one million gallons. These two tanks are served by two pristine wells with a capacity of nearly three million gallons per day.

Tri-State Utility, Inc operates under the authority and oversight from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Missouri Public Service Commission.

The Missouri Public Service Commission watchdog of consumer affairs in utility practices has set for it's guidelines in a set of rules of operations by means of a Tariff, which Tri-State Utility, Inc follows in it day to day operations of billing, collections, customer complaints, customer request, property protection and general governing of Tri-States actions to and for the customer.

The Department of Natural Resources is the governing body that regulates the safety of and purity of the potable water provided, system physical constructions, changes and testing. DNR is under the direct stewardship of the federal office of Environmental Protection Agency and Homeland Security.

Tri-State Utility, Inc is owned and operated by Harold I. Epps as President of the corporations board and Sharon R. Epps as its secretary/treasure of its corporation board and general manager.

As president the duties include but are not limited to all major construction and improvements, contracts and agreements, capital expenditures, and future growth, planning and development.

Secretary/Treasure duties include but are not limited to all personal and daily operations, customer complaint review, policy review and implementation, computer and data system implementation and security, records and retention, corporation minutes and seal.
