ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On August 23, 2006, Big River Telephone Company, LLC filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri. AT&T Missouri requested that the Commission order the parties to mediate their dispute, and Big River consented to mediation. The parties ultimately resolved their dispute, after which Big River filed a Motion to Dismiss.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116 allows a party to dismiss a complaint only by leave of the Commission, or by written consent of the adverse parties once prepared testimony has been filed. The Commission notes that prepared testimony has been filed. In light of successful mediation between Big River and AT&T Missouri, the Commission grants Big River leave to dismiss its complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Dismiss filed by Big River Telephone Company, LLC on June 12, 2009 is granted.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
