On November 7, 2007, Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC, Cellco Partnership, St. Joseph Celltelco and CyberTel Cellular Telephone Company filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. The Commission stayed the case at Complainants' request, so that Complainants and Respondent could pursue an interconnection amendment case at the Commission. Per Complainants' Motion to Stay Proceedings, if the Commission approves the amendment in Case No. IK-2008-0222, then the issues for which Complainants seek relief will become moot, and Complainants will dismiss their complaint.

On February 13, 2008, the Commission issued its Order Approving Amendments to Interconnection Agreement in Case No. IK-2008-0222. The order became effective

February 23, and the case closed February 24. In light of Complainant's assertion that they would dismiss if the Commission approved the amendments in Case No. IK-2008-0222, the Commission will order Complainants to either dismiss this complaint or to state cause why the Commission should not close this case.
