ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

On April 13, 2004, WWC License, LLC, asked the Commission to label it as an eligible telecommunications carrier. The Commission ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than January 7, 2005. Upon WWC License's motion, the Commission suspended that requirement until May 13.

On May 13, instead of a status report, WWC License filed its Motion for Leave to Dismiss without Prejudice. WWC License points to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116. That rule states that because prepared testimony has been filed, WWC License must seek leave of the Commission before it can dismiss the application. No parties have objected.

The Commission has reviewed WWC License's motion. Because no parties object, the Commission finds that it should grant WWC License's motion. The Commission will grant WWC License's leave to dismiss.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Motion for Leave to Dismiss without Prejudice filed by WWC License, LLC, is granted.
2. That the Commission grants leave to WWC License, LLC, to dismiss its application.
3. That this order shall become effective on June 24, 2005.
4. That this case shall be closed on June 25, 2005.
