ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On March 2, 2005, the Commission directed Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC, to comply with the Commission's previous order by filing either a copy of the Pooling Administrator Part 3 form verifying the return of unused telephone numbers or to file a status report. Six days out of time, on March 21, 2005, Charter filed a spreadsheet purporting to show the status of those numbers. In the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS), Charter stated that the purpose March 21, 2005, filing was to submit "a status report which indicates the telephone numbers retained for use in Wentzville and Pacific." Charter also indicated that the status had been discussed with Sara Buyak of the Commission Staff.

While Charter may have discussed this matter with Commission Staff, the spreadsheet on its face is not clear as to the status of the numbers requested from and returned to the Number Pooling Administrator. Thus, the record is unclear as to the status of these numbers. Charter's March 21 report does not comply with the Commission's previous two orders to provide a status report by a date certain. Charter is directed to comply with the Commission's order by filing either the Pooling Administrator's report or a

status report in the form of a pleading explaining why the Pooling Administrator's report is not available. Charter shall also state whether its transactions regarding this application are complete and whether it has fully complied with the Commission's order, thus allowing this case to be closed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That no later than May 10, 2005, Charter Fiberlink-Missouri, LLC, is directed to comply with the Commission's November 18, 2004, and March 2, 2005, orders as set out above.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on April 29, 2005.
