### **ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL EXTENSION OF TIME**

During the conference held in this matter on April 19, 2005, the judge directed the applicant, the Office of the Public Counsel, to file its final proposal or a status report on April 27, 2005. On that date, Public Counsel filed a request for an extension of time, until May 27, 2005, to file its final proposal. The Commission granted the request by order issued April 28, 2005.

On May 27, 2005, Public Counsel filed another request for an extension of time. Public Counsel notes that it has been discussing this matter with CenturyTel and that additional time is needed to explore the costs and the continuing community of interest in the proposed MCA reclassification. Therefore, Public Counsel requests an extension of time of 30 days to files its final recommendation.

The Commission has reviewed Pubic Counsel's request and finds that it is reasonable and should be granted.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Office of the Public Counsel shall file its final proposal in this matter no later than June 27, 2005.

2. That any party may file a response to the Office of the Public Counsel's final

proposal no later than July 7, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on June 2, 2005.
