Second Quarter FY 2007

The second quarter FY 2007 closing balance for the Deaf Relay and Adaptive Equipment Distribution Program Fund (Fund) was \$2,336,667, which is an increase of approximately \$99,500 or 4.5% from the previous quarter. Receipts for the quarter were about \$1,225,155 and expenditures were about \$1,125,778.

The Fund has increased by \$517,933 (or by 28%) since the surcharge was increased to \$0.13 in September 2005. Table 1 details Fund activity over the second quarter of FY 2007, October – December 2006, and Table 2 indicates general Fund activity for the past sixteen months, the period for which the \$0.13 surcharge has been effective.
