## STATUS REPORT OF SUMMIT NATURAL GAS OF MISSOURI, INC.

COMES NOW, Summit Natural Gas of Missouri, Inc. ("SNGMO" or "the Company"), and for its report to the Commission, states as follows:

A procedural conference was convened in this case on October 25, 2018, and was attended by representatives of SNGNO, the Commission Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel, Renew Missouri and the Missouri School Boards Association. At the outset of the proceeding, the presiding law judge asked that either a status report or a proposal for a procedural schedule be filed by November 8. After going off the record, the parties discussed the case generally. Thereafter, a follow-up meeting to informally discuss on November 9 with Company representatives topics implicated by the Federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 was scheduled. The parties have been unable to agree on what event or events should occur thereafter, but the Company's expectation is that discussions will be ongoing.
