**MOTION FOR EXTENSIONS OF TIME**

**COMES NOW** Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI), on behalf of itself, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission (collectively, the Parties), and for its *Motion for Extensions of Time*, states as follows:

1. On February 24, 2022, the Commission ordered Staff to file its recommendation in this case as soon as possible, but no later than March 9, 2022. The Commission also ordered the Parties to collaborate on a joint proposed procedural schedule to be filed by Staff no later than March 3, 2022.

2. ATXI intends to file brief supplemental testimony on or before March 11, 2022 regarding recent developments related to the proposed project that is the subject of this proceeding. To provide Staff an opportunity to review that supplemental filing, in conjunction with ATXI’s December 21, 2021 application, before Staff files its recommendation in this proceeding, and to provide the Parties an opportunity to collaborate regarding the appropriate procedural schedule thereafter, the Parties have authorized ATXI’s counsel to file this motion and request that the Commission grant (a) Staff an extension to file its recommendation; and (b) the Parties an extension, through and including March 16, 2022, to file a proposed procedural schedule, which will include a new deadline for Staff’s recommendation.

**WHEREFORE**, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois, on behalf of itself, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, and the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission, requests the Commission issue an order granting Staff an extension to file its recommendation in this case; granting the Parties an extension, through and including March 16, 2022, to file a proposed procedural schedule, which will include a new deadline for Staff's recommendation; and ordering such other and further relief as the Commission deems just in the circumstances.
