COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff” or “Complainant”), on behalf of itself and Officeplus Corporation of Missouri (“Officeplus” or “Respondent”) and submits their *Proposed List of Issues and Statement of Positions of the Parties* to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for the evidentiary hearing to be held in this case on July 15, 2004:

LIST OF CONTESTED ISSUES AND POSITIONS OF THE PARTIES

The parties have agreed upon the following list of contested issues and statements of position:

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission contends that Officeplus Corporation of Missouri did not file its 2002 Annual Report with the Commission in a timely

manner, consistent with Missouri statutes and Commission rules and orders. Officeplus does not dispute this assertion, but did file its annual report out of time. Officeplus contends that it is no longer doing business in Missouri, and is thus relieved of its obligation to file its annual report.

Issue: Is Officeplus relieved of its obligation to file its 2002 Annual Report with the Commission in a timely manner, as it is no longer doing business in Missouri?


Complainant: Officeplus is not relieved of its obligation to file its 2002 Annual Report with the Commission in a timely manner, consistent with Missouri statutes and Commission rules and orders.

Respondent: Officeplus agrees with the Commission Staff that it failed to comply with the requirement to timely file its 2002 Annual Report. Officeplus filed its 2002 Annual Report Out of Time. Officeplus is no longer doing business in Missouri, and requests that it no longer be required to file an Annual Report with the Commission.


