ORDER CHANGING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

An evidentiary hearing is schedule in this matter for September 28, 2005. Additionally, the procedural schedule in this matter requires that FullTel, Inc., and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, file briefs and a Statement of Facts on September 23, 2005.

Attorneys for FullTel and CenturyTel, through a conference call, informed the presiding judge that if this hearing proceeds as scheduled CenturyTel's attorney will be required to be in two hearings, at the same time, before the Commission. Furthermore, the onset of hurricane Rita has encumbered the life of one of CenturyTel's witnesses.

Both FullTel and CenturyTel agree that the hearing should be canceled. The parties further suggested that they be allowed to file briefs and a Statement of Facts on October 5, 2005. If FullTel and CenturyTel are able to agree on all of the facts, they request that the Commission not hold an evidentiary, but rather issue a summary judgment. Due to the

expedited nature of this proceeding, FullTel requests that the Commission issue its determination no later than October 18, 2005.

The Commission finds these requests reasonable and will cancel the hearing and change the date by which briefs and a Statement of Facts must be filed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the evidentiary hearing scheduled for September 28, 2005, at 8:30 a.m. is canceled.

2. That the FullTel, Inc., and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC shall file legal briefs and a Statement of Facts no later than October 5, 2005, rather than September 23, 2005.

3. That this order shall become effective on September 23, 2005.
