**ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S MOTION TO**  
**EXTEND FILING DATE FOR STAFF TESTIMONY**

On June 6, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed Staff's Motion to Extend Filing Date for Staff Testimony. Staff asks for a one day extension, from June 11 to June 12, to file its testimony, due to the press of other business. Staff indicates that neither the complainant nor the respondent objects, and that OPC is not taking an active role in the case.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. However, in light of Staff's assertion that no party objects to its motion, the Commission will waive the ten-day rule, and will take up Staff's motion unopposed. The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

2. Staff shall file its testimony no later than June 12, 2007.
3. This order shall become effective on June 7, 2007.
