ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO REQUEST FOR MEDIATION

On May 12, 2009,¹ the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a complaint against FamilyTel of Missouri, L.L.C. ("FamilyTel"). On June 26, FamilyTel filed a request for mediation, indicating its willingness to enter into third-party mediation. Before proceeding further, the Commission will allow the Complainant an opportunity to indicate whether it is also willing to enter into mediation regarding the complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 8, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a response to FamilyTel of Missouri, L.L.C.'s request for voluntary mediation, indicating whether it is willing to enter into such mediation.

2. The time allowed for FamilyTel of Missouri, L.L.C. to file its answer to the complaint is tolled until the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission has responded to the offer to mediate.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
