

Q. ALL QUESTIONS ARE DIRECTED TO COMCAST IP PHONE, LLC'S OFFERING AND PROVISION OF ITS ALL DISTANCE VOIP SERVICE TO CUSTOMERS IN MISSOURI. DOES COMCAST'S ALL DISTANCE VOIP SERVICE TRANSMIT INFORMATION BY WIRE, RADIO, OPTICAL CABLE, ELECTRONIC IMPULSES, OR OTHER SIMILAR MEANS BETWEEN POINTS IN TWO OR MORE EXCHANGES?

A. Subject to its previously filed objection, Comcast states that like all voice over internet protocol services, including those of Vonage, Verizon, AT&T and Skype, Comcast Digital Voice Service transmits information by wire, radio and optical cable that can be between points in two or more exchanges defined by AT&T.
