On March 8, 2007 the Missouri Universal Service Board, on the recommendation of the Fund Administrator, has determined that it is necessary to increase the assessment amount from \$0.0018 to \$0.0029. On March 8, 2007, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Commission Order Regarding Assessment and Motion for Expedited Treatment. Staff asks that the Commission issue an order approving such modification to the Missouri Universal Service Fund (MoUSF) assessment percentage for the Low-Income/Disabled portion of the MoUSF. The Commission finds that the Motion for Expedited Treatment is reasonable and will be approved.

Proper persons wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene with the Secretary of the Commission and shall send a copy of the application to intervene to all parties as directed below. The Data Center of the Commission shall serve a copy of this order on the legal counsel of AARP and on all telecommunications carriers in Missouri.
