ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On December 4, 2007, the Commission issued a Report and Order rejecting the tariffs of CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel that would have “grandfathered” the Remote Call Forwarding Services offered by those companies. The Report and Order provided that it would become effective on December 14. On December 13, CenturyTel of Missouri and Spectra filed a timely joint application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.” CenturyTel and Spectra cite various arguments for rehearing, but the Commission has previously considered and rejected each of those arguments. The Commission finds no reason to grant rehearing.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Joint Application for Rehearing filed by CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC, and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel, is denied.
2. This order shall become effective on December 20, 2007.
3. This case shall be closed on December 21, 2007.
