On February 14, 2007, Socket Telecom, LLC and Socket Holdings Corporation d/b/a Socket Internet filed a Request to Suspend or Reject Proposed Tariff Sheet. The Commission granted Socket's request, and suspended the above-referenced tariffs filed by Century Tel of Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel.

On February 21, Chariton Valley Telecom Corporation and Mark Twain Communications Company filed their File Application to Intervene. The Commission granted them intervention on March 7.

On April 25, Chariton Valley Telecom and Mark Twain Communications filed their Notice of Voluntary Dismissal. They stated that they have resolved their issues with Spectra Communications, and that they dismiss their intervention in this case.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116 states that an applicant may dismiss an application without order of the Commission before prepared testimony has been filed.

Prepared testimony has yet to be filed, so the Commission will take notice of the dismissal filed by Chariton Valley Telecom Corporation and Mark Twain Communications Company.
