ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On November 7, 2007, Verizon Wireless (VAW) LLC, Cellco Partnership, St. Joseph Celltelco and CyberTel Cellular Telephone Company filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, alleging that AT&T Missouri has unlawfully denied Verizon Wireless' request to extend their interconnection agreement.

Included with the complaint was an Entry of Appearance pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) from James G. Pachulski. Although the entry complies with that rule, the entry does not comply with Missouri Rules of Civil Procedure 6.01(m) and 9.03, which require counsel requesting to appear *pro hac vice* to pay the proper fee to the Clerk of The Supreme Court of Missouri, and to file with his or her initial pleading a receipt from the Clerk indicating that the fee has been paid.

The Commission will order Mr. Pachulski to comply with the above-cited Missouri Rules of Civil Procedure, or withdraw his entry of appearance.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. James G. Pachulski shall comply with the above-cited Missouri Rules of Civil Procedure, or withdraw his appearance, no later than December 10, 2007.
2. This order shall become effective on November 8, 2007.
