ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On November 28, 2007, Sprint Communications Company, L.P., Sprint Spectrum, L.P., Nextel West Corp., and NPCR, Inc., filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. The Commission sent AT&T Missouri notice of the complaint on December 10, 2007. On January 4, 2008, AT&T Missouri requested mediation of this complaint. Sprint consented to that mediation.

The mediator filed a report on April 8, stating that mediation did not result in settlement of the parties' dispute. The Commission notes that in its December 10, 2007 notice, it notified the parties that AT&T Missouri's 30-day time period in which to answer the complaint would be suspended upon receipt of a request for mediation. Now that mediation has ended, the Commission will allow AT&T Missouri the remainder of its 30-day deadline to answer Sprint's complaint.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, shall answer the complaint no later than April 14, 2008.
2. This order shall become effective on April 9, 2008.
