8	Inc. and St. Joseph Light & Power Company for
9	authority to merge St. Joseph Light & Power Company
10	with and into UtiliCorp United Inc., and, in
11	connection therewith, certain other related
12	transactions.
13	We're here today for a prehearing
14	conference. And to start things out we'll go ahead by
15	taking entries of appearance. And since UtiliCorp and
16	St. Joseph Light and Power are the applicants in this
17	case, we'll start with UtiliCorp.

9	to make a written response to those, you can do so by
LO	Monday at three o'clock. It would be the 13th. And
11	of course, the Commission will consider those also.
L2	And the Commission will rule on a motion,
L3	the motion to require a market power study after the
L4	proposed procedural schedules are submitted, in the
L5	hopes that perhaps you can resolve that issue as well
L6	today. At least discuss it and come up with your
L7	positions on it.

L9	wants to bring up while we're on the record?
