APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

Comes now TruComm Corporation ("TruComm" or "Applicant"), by its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to §§ 392.410 through 392.440 *et seq.*, RSMo, and hereby respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant it authority to provide resale intrastate, interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services throughout the state of Missouri as permitted under the law, and classify its services as competitive. Pursuant to §392.361 and §392.420, RSMo, the Applicant also seeks a waiver of certain of the Commission's requirements for intrastate, interexchange and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service offerings. In support of its Application, TruComm states as follows:

1. Applicant TruComm Corporation is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Illinois with its principal place of business at: 1608 Barclay Blvd., Buffalo Grove, Illinois 60089. The character of business performed by Applicant is telecommunications services. A copy of Applicant's Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State, as required by 4 CSR 240-

2.060(1)(C), is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

3. By this Application, TruComm Corporation seeks authority to operate as an intrastate, interexchange carrier providing resold and facilities-based intrastate,

interexchange services and non-switched local exchange services throughout the State of Missouri. TruComm proposes to provide long distance and non-switched private line local exchange telecommunications services and prepaid calling card services to residential and business customers throughout the State of Missouri.

4. Applicant requests a temporary waiver of 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C), which requires that an application for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, local exchange or basic local exchange service shall include a proposed tariff with a forty-five (45) day effective date. Applicant will promptly file a tariff with a 45-day effective date as soon as possible, once it has entered into or adopted necessary interconnection agreements.

5. The Applicant has the requisite managerial, technical, and financial qualifications to operate a viable business and provide the services sought to be provided in Missouri.

6. Applicant submits that the public interest will be served by Commission approval of this application because Applicant's proposed services will create and enhance competition and expand customer service options consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter 392 RSMo. Prompt approval of this application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

7. As a new market entrant, TruComm requests streamlined regulatory treatment afforded similarly situated telecommunications carriers in Missouri. Likewise, to the extent the Commission has granted other competitive interexchange and local

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exchange carriers a waiver of certain of the Commission's rules and regulations, TruComm respectfully requests that it be granted the same waivers.

8. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated telecommunications companies, TruComm respectfully requests that, pursuant to §392.361.5 and §392.420, RSMo, the following statutes and regulations be waived with respect to its interexchange service offerings:

To the extent that the Commission may modify its waiver policies, TruComm respectfully reserves the right to amend its waiver requests accordingly.

10. Applicant herein states, in accordance with 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(K), that there are no pending actions or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against

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Applicant in any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates for which action, judgment, or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of this Application.

11. Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(L), Applicant hereby states that the Company does not have any overdue annual reports or assessment fees owed to the Missouri Public Service Commission.

12. TruComm requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. The Applicant believes that the highly developed state of the interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services market in Missouri and nationwide ensures that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to warrant a less rigorous degree of regulation.

WHEREFORE, TruComm Corporation respectfully requests that the Commission: (a) grant it a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate, interexchange, and non-switched local exchange, telecommunications services, as requested herein; (b) classify the Company and its proposed services as competitive; (c) grant waivers of statutes and regulations as requested herein; and (d) approve its separately submitted tariff.
