**TRUE-UP LIST OF ISSUES, ORDER OF OPENING STATEMENTS,

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and states:

1. On November 14, 2012, the Commission issued in these cases an *Order Directing Filing* in which it directed Staff, after consulting the other parties, to “file a list of issues, order of opening statements, list of witnesses, and order of cross-examination for the true-up hearing” by “no later than 5:00 p.m. on November 16, 2012.”

2. In compliance with that order Staff prepared a list of issues, order of opening statements, list of witnesses, and order of cross-examination. In preparing that list of issues for the true-up hearing, Staff, for consistency and ease, identified them to correspond to the list of issues it filed on October 11, 2012.

3. Subsequently, late in the afternoon of November 16, 2012, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Motions to Strike Testimony of Witness Gorman and Partially Strike Testimony of Witness Harris*. In light of that order, Staff revised its

list of issues, order of opening statements, list of witnesses, and order of cross-examination. They follow.
