ORDER ADOPTING PROTECTIVE ORDER

On March 15, 2006, R. Mark filed a Complaint against "AT&T a/k/a SBC a/k/a Southwestern Bell Telephone Company". The Commission finds that the intended respondent is known to the Commission as Southwestern Bell Telephone, LP, d/b/a AT&T Missouri, and will refer to the respondent herein as AT&T Missouri unless and until it determines that the complainant intends a different party.

The Complaint alleges, among other things, that R. Mark is being improperly billed for the service of maintaining a non-published telephone number. Complainant also asserts that the information contained in an attachment to his Complaint is "confidential" and asks that it "not be made a part of the public record."

Upon review of R. Mark's Complaint and attachment, the Commission finds that there is a need to protect confidential information and considers the complainant's request as one for a protective order. The request is reasonable and will be granted to this limited extent.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Complainant R. Mark is granted a protective order to prevent the disclosure

to the general public of his telephone number, which is listed on the page marked "confidential" and attached to the Complaint.

2. That this order shall become effective on March 16, 2006.
