ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND HEARING SCHEDULE

On September 11, 2007, the Staff of the Commission, Socket Telecom, LLC, CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel, filed a Joint Motion to Extend Hearing Schedule. The parties ask the Commission to move the hearing from September 18-19 to October 18-19 to allow the parties to continue to pursue settlement. They further indicate that OPC is not taking an active role in the case.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to pleadings. Furthermore, the Commission will remind the parties that tariffs are suspended until December 18, and that no further suspension is possible. Therefore, the Commission will be hesitant to grant any further continuances.
