Syllabus: This order denies the applications for rehearing filed by Socket Telecom, LLC and CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel.

On March 26, 2008, the Commission issued its Report and Order. On April 4, both Socket and CenturyTel filed Applications for Rehearing.
