During the evidentiary hearing, Socket Telecom, LLC, testified concerning a July 10, 2007 LNPA-WG meeting, and stated that the LNPA-WG closed PIM-60 in Socket's favor.1 Further, Socket stated that PIM-60 would be added to the LNPA-WG's best practices document.² The parties agreed that Socket and CenturyTel could testify as to their respective recollection of what happened during the July 10, 2007 meeting.³
