ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 19, 2007, Socket Telecom, LLC filed a complaint against CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC and Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel, alleging that CenturyTel is violating a Commission-approved interconnection agreement by its refusal to fulfill orders to port certain numbers. Because Socket requested expedited treatment, the Commission shortened the time for CenturyTel's answer. CenturyTel answered on April 2, denying Socket's allegations.

The Commission will set this case for prehearing conference. At that prehearing conference, the parties shall discuss whether they are amenable to filing a stipulation of facts. Also, if the parties are unable to agree on a proposed procedural schedule, the parties shall, at a minimum, propose alternative schedules.
