## ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION AND MODIFICATION AND MODIFYING ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

Issue Date: October 4, 2007 Effective Date: October 11, 2007

On October 2, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission brought to the attention of the Commission an issue of the interpretation of the Order Granting Default issued on September 6, 2007. In that order, the Commission intended to grant authority to its General Counsel to seek a judgment for money owed to the Missouri Universal Service Fund and the Deaf Relay Service and Equipment Distribution Fund. The Order Granting Default as written, however, is not clear that the General Counsel is so authorized. Therefore, the Commission shall modify its order so that Ordered Paragraph 4 reads as set out below.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion for Clarification and Modification is granted.

- 2. The Order Granting Default issued on September 6, 2007, is modified so that Ordered Paragraph 4 of that order reads as follows:
  - 4. The General Counsel of the Commission is authorized to recover past-due surcharges in the Circuit Court, and pursuant to Section 386.360, RSMo 2000, to file a petition in Circuit Court to seek such judgments as necessary, including a writ of mandamus or injunction against Winstar Communications, Inc., to recover surcharges and compel compliance with the relevant statutes and regulations.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on October 11, 2007.
