On November 28, 2007, Sprint Communications Company, L.P., Sprint Spectrum, L.P., Nextel West Corp., and NPCR, Inc., filed a complaint against Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri. On April 14, 2008, after mediation failed to resolve this complaint, AT&T Missouri answered Sprint's petition, and also filed a Motion to Dismiss on the grounds that the Commission does not have jurisdiction over the complaint. Sprint replied on April 24, asserting that the Commission does have jurisdiction.

The Commission will order its Staff to state whether it believes the Commission has jurisdiction.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a pleading as directed above no later than May 9, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective on April 28, 2008.
