On June 9, 2008, West 16th Street Sewer Company (hereafter "West 16th") filed a rate increase request letter. West 16th asked the Commission to allow it to increase its rates by \$52,945.68.

On November 6, 2008 the Staff of the Commission (hereafter "Staff") filed an Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request. The Agreement was between Staff and West 16th only; the Office of the Public Counsel (hereafter "OPC") did not join in the agreement. The Commission held a local public hearing on January 5, 2009.

On January 21, 2009, OPC filed a request for an evidentiary hearing. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050(20) states that once OPC requests an evidentiary hearing, the "utility's pending tariff revision shall then be suspended". Therefore, the Commission will further suspend the tariff to allow time for the case to proceed to hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

That the following tariff sheet filed by West 16th Street Sewer Company, and assigned Tariff File No. YS-2009-0335, is suspended until May 9, 2009, or until otherwise ordered by the Commission:
