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1 required by the Company's four employees in keeping time records, and the overtime worked by
2 employees after hours or on weekends for which they are not currently being compensated.

3 Q. Does the Company's employees' status as exempt or non-exempt change Staff's
4 recommendation with regard to establishing and maintaining a time reporting mechanism for
5 each employee?

6 A. No. Regardless of employees' exempt or non-exempt classification, Staff
7 recommends that all employees maintain time records.

8 Q. Does Staff intend for the Company to establish an elaborate time reporting system
9 that would require the Company's employees extensive time and effort to develop and maintain?

10 A. No. In my Direct Testimony, page 5, lines 8-9, I stated that time reporting is not
11 intended to be burdensome. Recording appropriate descriptions of work performed, broken into
12 specific time increments, should not take more than a few minutes each day per employee. A
13 simple, inexpensive notebook or spreadsheet could be used for recording purposes. The
14 Company would then have documentation on the specific activities and actual number of hours
15 worked by its employees.

16 Q. Is Mr. Sherry requesting additional revenue to pay for overtime?

17 A. Yes. On page 10, lines 14-19 of his Direct Testimony, Mr. Sherry is requesting
18 \$10,033 to pay overtime for two positions – the Plant and Collection System Operator and the
19 Office Manager, along with increased workers' compensation and general liability insurance.
20 Staff witness Bret G. Prenger will be addressing this issue in his Rebuttal Testimony.

21 Q. Has Staff included an amount for overtime in its calculations?

1 A. Yes. It is my understanding that Staff witness Bret G. Prenger has included a
2 level of overtime in the amount of \$7,000 in total payroll costs included in this case based on
3 estimates provided by the Company for 2009.

4 Q. Does this conclude your Rebuttal Testimony?

5 A. Yes, it does.

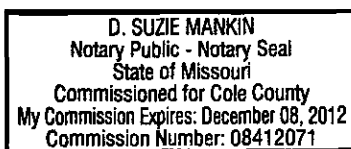


