- 1. The telephone number relief efforts are guided by the North American Numbering Plan Administrator ("NANPA") and the Industry Committee which is comprised of interested industry participants. Telephone numbers within the 573 area code are expected to exhaust within the third quarter of 2024. The Industry Committee has been meeting monthly since February 2023 in order to discuss the status of available numbers within the area code and the implementation of milestones. This is summarized in the Staff's Memorandum attached as Appendix A.
- 2. In addition to Appendix A, also attached are: Attachment A Consumer education milestones and Attachment B Technical implementation milestones.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will accept its Status Report and grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just in the circumstances.

Subject: Status update for 573 area code telephone number relief

Telephone numbers within the 573 area code are projected to exhaust sometime within the third quarter of 2024. Telephone number relief efforts are being guided by the Industry Committee and the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA). The Industry Committee is comprised of interested industry participants utilizing telephone number resources within the 573 area code and the Committee has been meeting on a monthly basis since February 2023. In general, the monthly meetings discuss the status of available numbers within the area code as well as implementation milestones typically applied in any relief effort. Milestones specific to providing numbering relief in the 573 area code are identified in Attachment A (consumer education milestones) and Attachment B (technical implementation milestones).

January 16, 2024 is the earliest date companies can request telephone numbers from NANPA with the new 235 area code, and March 24, 2024 is the earliest date the 235 area code will be activated and used. Consumers will be required to use ten digit dialing, rather than seven digits, for local calls by February 2024. The industry has begun educating customers about the new area code and the requirement to dial the area code + telephone number (10 digits) through customer notices with a target date of all companies sending notice by July 26, 2023. Among future consumer education efforts, a press release advising of permissive ten digit dialing, followed by a press release advising of mandatory ten digit dialing will be issued by the target dates of August 21, 2023 and February 19, 2024, respectively.

² This committee is tri-chaired by AT&T's Sharon Poer, Brightspeed's Dale Holcombe and Lumen's Rita Schmitz. Cecilia McCabe is overseeing telephone number relief efforts for the 573 area code on behalf of NANPA. The committee is currently comprised of over 70 participants.

³ Industry Committee conference calls were held February 23, 2023; March 16, 2023 and April 20, 2023. The next scheduled Industry Committee conference call is May 18, 2023 at 12:00 PM with future monthly calls scheduled for the third Thursday of the month at 12:00 PM.

The Industry Committee intends to continue to monitor telephone number relief efforts and depending on when telephone numbers actually exhaust in the 573 area code, the date carriers can obtain numbers in the new 235 area code and when the 235 area code will be activated and used may be adjusted accordingly if needed.
