

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION
FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

CAT Communications International, Inc. filed an Application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on December 8, 1999 for a certificate of service authority to provide resold interexchange and basic local telecommunications service in Missouri and for competitive classification.

The Company hereby requests that its application be amended as follows:

- (1) Section 9 on Page 5 of the Application should be amended to read as follows:

The Company hereby requests a waiver of 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(H) which requires that an application for certificate of service authority to provide interexchange, non-switched local exchange or basic local exchange telecommunications service include a proposed tariff with a forty-five day effective date. The Company has not received Commission approval of any resale agreements with incumbent local exchange companies. At such time as all facts necessary for the development of such tariffs are known to the Company, it will promptly file said tariffs with the Commission in a manner consistent with recent Commission practice in similar cases.

WHEREFORE, CAT Communications International, Inc. hereby requests that the Commission proceed with its Application, as amended, and grant the requested authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services, grant all waivers requested, and classify the Company as a competitive telecommunications company.
