On May 9, 2008, Peerless Network of Missouri, LLC, filed an application with the Commission for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services, for classification as a competitive carrier, and for waiver of certain Commission rules. After receiving a favorable Staff Recommendation, the Commission approved Peerless' application on June 30. In that order, the Commission reminded Peerless it could not provide service until it had a Commission-approved tariff.

On July 11, Peerless filed a tariff which was due to become effective August 25. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a Recommendation. Peerless has since withdrawn its tariff. The Commission, therefore, will relieve Staff of its duty to file a Recommendation.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission is no longer required to file a Recommendation.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
