ORDER REGARDING JOINT STATUS REPORTS

On March 30, 2012, True Wireless, L.L.C. and the Commission's Staff filed a joint status report. The parties state that True Wireless is seeking approval of a compliance plan, which is relevant to this application, from the Federal Communications Commission. Because the time required for the FCC determination will exceed the Commission's deadline for filing reports that were previously ordered by the Commission, the Commission will extend that filing deadline by 90 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. True Wireless, L.L.C. and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall continue to file a joint monthly status report on the first business day of each month, until such time as this case is closed.
2. The May 21, 2012 deadline for filings that was set in the Commission's February 21, 2012 "Order Directing Status Reports and Ninety-Day Filings" is canceled.
3. If the Commission's Staff has not filed a final recommendation for approval or disapproval of True Wireless, L.L.C.'s application by August 20, 2012, then the Commission's Staff shall file a memorandum of explanation stating, with particularity, why it has not completed its investigation and why it is not providing the Commission with a recommendation.

4. If the Commission's Staff has not filed a final recommendation for approval or disapproval of True Wireless, L.L.C.'s application by August 20, 2012, then True Wireless, L.L.C. shall show cause as to why this matter should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

5. The filings directed in paragraphs 3 and 4 shall be filed no later than August 20, 2012.

6. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
