CenturyTel of Missouri, LLC ("CenturyTel") and Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel ("Spectra") are not parties to this proceeding, but we are writing to express our support for the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") suspending the procedural schedule in this case.

As Respondent Comcast IP Phone, LLC ("Comcast") and Intervener Missouri Independent Telephone Group ("MITG"), have indicated in the Joint Motion to Suspend the Procedural Schedule, and Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri") has concurred by letter dated April 23, 2007, a joint study group is being formed, with representation of all interested stakeholders, to examine the issues of Voice over Internet Protocol regulation at the end of the current legislative session of the Missouri General Assembly. This joint study group is interested in reviewing these issues as they affect the telecommunications industry as a whole.

CenturyTel and Spectra concur with Comcast, MITG, AT&T Missouri and other interested parties that have filed in support of the Joint Motion that the procedural schedule in this case should be suspended while the interim study group meets.
